

Deputy who helped save man's life to be honored today by Rep. Miller

Escambia County Deputy Karen Bray will be honored today for the actions she took Jan. 9 when a man was injured in a motorcycle accident.

Bray will receive a congressional recognition certificate and a letter from U.S. Rep Jeff Miller, R-Chumuckla.

George Orf, 48, was knocked into a guardrail when the motorcycle he was on collided with a van on county roads 97 and 297A. Orf's left leg was severed and was bleeding profusely.

Bray took a belt from a man who had stopped to help and wrapped it around Orf's leg, using it as a tourniquet to stop the bleeding.

Sharon Santurri, a district representative for Miller, will present the certificate and letter to Bray at the Sheriff's Office on Leonard Street at 3 p.m. today.
