

Man stabbed Monday in fight outside home on Yonge Street

A man was stabbed twice in the abdomen Monday during a fight outside a Yonge Street home.

The man, whose identity was not immediately available, was taken to Baptist Hospital. The man's injuries were not believed to be life-threatening, Escambia County Sheriff's Office Lt. Rex Blackburn said.

The Sheriff's Office was called about 7 p.m.

The victim knocked on the door and punched the homeowner after the homeowner answered the door, Blackburn said. The homeowner's brother intervened and also was hit.

As the three fought, the victim was stabbed.

The stabbing victim's girlfriend was at the house, Blackburn said.

No charges have been filed in the case. The investigation is ongoing.
